

## **Unlock – the final push?**

Whilst national restrictions are lifted from Monday 19<sup>th</sup> July churches are mindful that some may not be comfortable with the immediate removal of all safety measures. The plan is to ease off gradually, still providing space for those who wish to be a bit more cautious. If we feel more/less comfortable than anticipated, dates can be adjusted. - Livestreaming will continue
- Use of hand sanitizer is encouraged
- The collection plate at the back of church will remain
- Track and trace comes to an end immediately
- Socially distanced pews will be available throughout July & August (if needed)

### **From Sunday 25<sup>th</sup> July**

- Face coverings encouraged arriving/leaving the building; removed when seated
- Congregational hymn singing (3 congregational, 1 choir only)
- Socially-distanced sharing of the Peace
- Holy Communion in one kind, standing
- Stewards for Communion / end of service

### **From Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> August**

- Face coverings optional
- Return to full congregational hymn singing
- Optional physical sharing of the Peace
- Holy Communion received kneeling at the altar rail

### **From Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> August**

- The chalice will be offered at Communion but as an 'option'
- After-church refreshments can be offered

### **From Sunday 29<sup>th</sup> August**

- Offertory procession
- A return to a full sung Eucharist

### **From Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> September**

- Sidespeople return to duties
- Sunday School can resume
