This is part of the massive project to plant 16,000 trees for Rossendale Forest. The first two planting sessions of 2024 will be taking place at Clough Edge Farm, off Reeds Lane, Crawshaw Grange, BB4 8PR, where the aim is to plant 850 trees. The sessions are due to take place between 10am and 3pm on Saturday the 17th February and also between 10am and 3pm on Thursday 22nd February.
